U. S. Navy Completes Observation of Conditions During Channel Maintenance Activities at Little Salado Creek near NASA Crows Landing Flight Facility

The Navy observed channel maintenance activities conducted by the San Luis & Delta-Mendota Water Authority during the period from 8 through 15 June 2004 along Little Salado Creek near NASA Crows Landing Flight Facility, California. Two munitions experts were at the site for the duration of the maintenance work to visually inspect the soil before, during, and after dredging to determine if munitions were present. No munitions items were found. A summary of the observations from the channel maintenance activities has been prepared and a copy of the summary is available for public inspection in the Navy's Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act Administrative Record Files and the information repository at the Stanislaus County Library, Patterson Branch on 46 North Salado, Patterson, California (Telephone: 209 892-6473).
