

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

**NAVY HAS SIGNED A FINDING OF SUITABILITY TO TRANSFER FOR  
SURPLUS PROPERTIES AT THE FORMER  
NAVAL FUEL DEPOT POINT MOLATE  
RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA**

In accordance with Department of Defense guidelines on the process to reach a Finding of Suitability to Transfer (FOST), notice is hereby given that the Department of the Navy has signed a FOST on May 27, 2003, in connection with the disposal of properties at the former Naval Fuel Depot Point Molate by deed to a non-federal government entity.

The property subject to this FOST covers approximately 364 acres. The proposed reuse is consistent with Alternative 2, which is detailed in the Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report, February 2002, developed by the City of Richmond and Southwest Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command. Reuse includes commercial, light industrial, recreational and open space.

The public was invited to review and comment on this proposed transfer. The public review and comment period began on February 21, 2003, and ended on March 24, 2003.
